Qualification content, structure and outcomes

- mental ill health, treatment options available and the potential consequences of mental ill health, the skills required to work in the mental health service.

To achieve this qualification you'll need to complete 5 mandatory units:

- Understanding the context of mental health and wellbeing
- Promotion of mental health and wellbeing
- Mental health problems: associated issues and consequences
- Understanding mental ill health
- Working in mental health

There are no optional units.

Similar qualifications

This is the only Level 3 Certificate in Understanding Mental Health offered by us and it supports progression from Level 2 Mental Health qualifications.

The only similar qualification we offer is the Level 3 Award in the Awareness of the Mental Capacity Act 2005. This qualification aims to provide you with an understanding of the Mental Capacity Act 2005 and Code of Practice when working with individuals who lack capacity and will give you the knowledge to apply this in your work role.
